The **Lemuel Clapp House** (1765) and the **William Clapp House** (1806) will show the domestic side of 19th century life, while the carriage house and barn will demonstrate the agricultural side. **Rick Detwiler**, architect and President of the Georgetown Historical Society, will lecture on New England barns.

EarthWorks will demonstrate the making of cider. The kitchen of the William Clapp House is filled with cooking and laundry objects. The Lemuel Clapp House has artifacts used in the linen-making process and examples of needlework from the first half of the 19th century.
